

Producer Overview



Oak Ridge Winery is the oldest operating winery in Lodi, California, built in 1934. It is owned by the Maggio & Reynolds families, and produces estate wines under several separate wine labels. The area's uniquely Mediterranean climate, with warm days and coastal evening breezes, is ideal for the cultivation of world-class wine grapes. California's top varietals thrive here, with zinfandel being a singular phenomenon. Vines, some over 100 years old, produce small yields of intensely flavored fruit to create wines that are the ultimate expression of the terroir. In 2002, the families began an extensive and comprehensive renovation that transformed Oak Ridge Winery into a state-of-the-industry facility, capable of meeting the quality, style, and volume demands of a growing and evolving global marketplace.

Lodi's wine region, sixty miles east of San Francisco, is influenced by dramatic day to night temperature changes of up to 40°F. Ripe, intense, classic and the ultimate expression of the king of all red wines - Lodi Estates Cabernet Sauvignon.



Lodi Estates Cabernet Sauvignon

This wine is a selection of the best Cabernet Sauvignon grapes harvested from our estate-owned vineyards. The finest oak regimen available is utilized, carefully matching the fine rich tannins and elegant flavors of this Cabernet. After a carefully selected period of time to allow the tannins, fruit and oak to meld, the wine reflects the elegant richness and bright fruit that the Lodi region has become renowned for. Pair with Beef Tenderloin with Roasted Garlic and Pickled Shiitakes, Pan-seared Lamb Cutlets Seared in Olive Oil with Shallots.

This robust, age-worthy Cabernet Sauvignon comes out of the bottle with powerful aromas of cocoa, cedar and limestone. These vibrant aromas are but a prelude to lush, elegant flavors of blueberry, raspberry, milk chocolate, mocha, vanilla and black pepper. A silky smooth mouth-feel belies the original boldness of this wine and is followed by fine tannins, a full, round texture, and a long, lingering finish.
